Richards who was leading overnight shot a level par 72 today for a 3 day total of 217.

Amateur Jonathan Millen continues to the lead the amateur contingent and is in 2nd place overall adding a 75 today to his 2 day total for a total of 220. In third place is junior Liam Bryden who shot 74 today is now on 229 total. Clint Alfred rounds out the leading 4 players with a 3 day total of 235 who would like to go to Jamaica to play in the Latinamerican Tour Jamaica Classic in July. There are 4 players tied on 237 who will certainly give them a run for the top 4 places. They Canadian Arnold Johnson, Anthony Gill, Bernard Benny and Xzavier Wiggins of Barbados.

In the first flight, who played from the Blue tees , Randy Hakim extended his lead to 6 strokes adding a 78 to his 2 day total for a 3 day total of 242 strokes. Zico Correia has moved into 2nd place with his 3rd round 81 giving him a total of 248. One stroke further back is Steve Durgadeen of Pointe-a-Pierre G.C. his 81 today leaving him on 249. Junior Charles fell back to 4th with an 85 today for a 250 total

In the second flight, Jonathan Mitchell the overnight leader has increased his lead to a commanding 9 strokes adding a fine 76 to take his 3 day total to 234 strokes. Eun Dae Lee remained in 2nd place with 82 for a total of 245. Joe Rahael surged up the field with a great round of 81 for a total of 252. Youngster Ethan Baptiste of Tobago is one stroke further back adding another score of 77 to total 253

In the Seniors division we have a new leader in Deryck Gonsalves , who had a 76 today for a total of 233. Adrian Sampson the overnight leader is one stroke further back after shooting 78 to lie on 234. But the defending champion Reynold Deonath shot a brilliant 74 to lie 2 strokes off of the pace on 236. Krishna Narine shooting a 79 is now 7 strokes behind on 240.

The Super Seniors is now led by Fabian Lee Foon who shot 76 again today for a 3 day total of 231. Fabian was 1 under par through the first 9 holes. John Hale a member of the host club had the best round in the Super Seniors today shooting 75 to lie just 2 strokes behind on 233. Defending Champion Arjoon Samlal is now 5 strokes off of the pace with his 81 giving him a 236 total

In the Presidents Cup Trinidad & Tobago's pair of Liam Bryden 79, 76, 74 total 229 and Richard "Pecos" Camacho 80,81,78 239 have a total 468 and have increased their lead over Barbados to 23 strokes. With Julian Jordan 82,77,84 total 243 and Iz Hustler 85,82,81, total 248 having a team total 491.
