After 3 rounds of the 111th Trinidad & Tobago Open once again played in beautiful conditions at the St Andrews Golf Club in Moka, Maraval , Canadian professional Dustin Risdon shot a 74 for a total of 220 and increased his lead to 5 strokes. Local professional Chris Richards is in second after shooting 77 for a total of 225. England based Timothy Martin is in 3rd after shooting 73 to total 226. Matthew Marquez is one stroke further back on 227 with his 76 today. Benjamin Martin is on 228 after his score of 76 today. So it should be an interesting tussle for the 3 positions up for grabs in the Latinoamerican Tour Jamaica Classic, at the end of April.

The championship division is led by Gabriel Vanososte who is based in the USA, and shot 74 today for a three day total of 228, local Sam Avey is in second on 231 after shooting 76. With Felix Zamudio two strokes further back on 233 after his 77 today. Ryan Peters follows on 234 with Russel Latapy following on 235.

In the first flight, who played from the Blue tees, former National cricketer Richard Smith once again was the only player to shoot under 80 in this division. Richard added a 78 to yesterday brilliant 75 and his total of 239 means he now leads by 4 strokes from Omesh Dinanath who shot 81 for a three day total of 243. Phillip Subero is in third with a total of 246 and Thomas Bannon in fourth on 247.

In the second flight, Eun Dae Lee the overnight leader has increased his lead to 4 strokes with a three day total of 255 he shot 85 today. Tied in second place on 259 strokes are Nandlal Ramlakhan and Robert Benny who both shot 87 today. Learie Flores 81 and Richard Lutchman 73 are one stroke further back on 260.

In the Seniors' division defending champion Adrian Sampson continues to lead the way shooting 79 today for a total of 233. In second place is Wayne Baptiste who also shot 79 today and is 3 strokes back with 236. Dave Rajkumar shot 81 to lie 4 strokes off of the pace on 237.

Fabian Lee Foon continues to lead the Super Seniors shooting his worst round of the tournament an 81 for a 3 day total of 240. Fabian was only 2 over par on the front nine but the back nine took its toll as he came back in 43 shots. John Hale a member of the host club is in second place with a 3 day total of 246 after shooting 84 today. Tied in third place are Ronald Aguilar and Monty Chapman both members of Millennium Lakes G&CC who both shot 78 today and have a total of 249.
