### **Trinidad & Tobago Men's' Golf Team Finish in Third Place**

#### **Port of Spain, Trinidad**

On the last day of the 2016 Caribbean Amateur Golf Championships being played on the Ocean Club Course in Paradise Island Bahamas, the Hoerman Cup team were unable to continue their good play but were still able to maintain their third place.

The winners in the closest finish ever were the Dominican Republic whose last player on the course Juan Jose Guerra sank a 40 foot putt for birdie to pip the Puerto Ricans by 1 stroke. Puerto Rico had a 6 stroke lead going into the last day but succumbed to the Dominican Republic brilliant team total of 11 under par.

Today Trinidad & Tobago were led by Liam Brydens' level par 72; Matthew Marquez added a two over par 74, Wan Ju Lee a 76, with 77's from Talin Rajendranath and Clint Alfred. Sachin Kumar was unable to maintain the high standard of golf that he had displayed over the first 3 days and ended the tournament with a disappointing 78.
