

Trinidad & Tobago's Lee Wins Individual Medalist Title: Cobras Claim Second at SAC Men's Golf Championship after Four-Hole Playoff

SALISBURY, N.C. – The Coker College men's golf team finished second at the 2017 South Atlantic Conference Men's Golf Championship Tournament, while sophomore Wanjoo Lee won the individual title.

The Cobras shot a team score of 141 in round two, which was shortened to nine holes due to heavy rainfall and severe flooding. Coker's one-over team score in round two forced a playoff with Carson-Newman University.

The playoff format consisted of all five players for each side playing the hole, with the teams combining the four-lowest scores. The two teams would play four playoff holes, with a Carson-Newman chipping in on a fourth playoff hole to win the title.

Wanjoo Lee, who shot back-to-back rounds of one-under par, won the 2017 South Atlantic Conference individual title by two strokes. Wanjoo who has been a member of both T&T's Junior & senior teams for the last 6 years has been putting in a lot of hard work on the golf course and is now beginning to see the fruits of his labors.

The Cobras will wait to see if they earn a berth into the NCAA South/Southeast Regional Championship.
