The Trinidad & Tobago men's and women's teams sponsored by the Sport Company RBC and TOFCO start their quest to win the 2016 Caribbean Amateur Golf Championships in the Bahamas.

The men's team comprises of 6 players, Sachin Kumar the winner of the 2016 Trinidad & Tobago Open, Matthew Marquez the winner of the national trials, Talin Rajendranath (national Captain), Clint Alfred (2nd in 2016 T&T Open, Wan Ju Lee(multiple times national player) and Liam Bryden (winner of the Las Vegas Stars tournament last week). This year with the best 4 scores each day counting each day it is believed that this is the team that can win back the Hoerman Cup.

The ladies team comprises of Christina Ferreira (multiple representative on the national team), Ysabelle Lawrence (winner of many local tournaments), Serena Mackenzie (recently represented T&T in the British Junior Open) and newcomer to the team Karina Matabadal. The ladies will be playing for the George Teale trophy which they last won in 2015. This year the two best scores each day count for the ladies.

The tournament will consist of 4 rounds to be played on the famed Ocean Club Course on Paradise Island and the teams are staying at the Atlantis resort. The venue was the host for the Opening tournament of the 2016 LPGA tour.
