Trinidad & Tobago Men's Golf Team in Third Place

Port of Spain, Trinidad



On the third day of the 2016 Caribbean Amateur Golf Championships being played on the Ocean Club Course in Paradise Island Bahamas, the Hoerman Cup team continued their good play but unfortunately was unable to keep up with the Puerto Ricans.

Sachin Kumar once again led the way with a 3 under par 69; he was backed up by Matthew Marquez and Captain Talin Rajendranath who both shot 2 under par 70's. The fourth counting score was Clint Alfred's one over par 73. Liam Bryden with 75 and Wan Ju Lee with a 77 did not count today. Their combined 6 under par 282 is the lowest score ever shot by a Trinidad & Tobago team.

Puerto Rico shot a 10 under par total of 278, led by a 66 by Erick Morales. The Dominican Republic matched Trinidad & Tobago's 6 under par 282 and they were led by a 66 from Rhadames Pena.
