TRINIDAD & TOBAGO NATIONAL GOLF TEAM IS SET FOR THE CARIBBEAN AMATEUR GOLF CHAMPIONSHIPS

This year the 61^{st} Caribbean Amateur Golf Championships will take place in the Dominican Republic from July 30^{th} – August 5^{th} at the Links at Casa de Campo.

The teams are competing for the Hoerman Cup (men) and the George Teale Memorial Trophy (women).

This years' team is nicely balanced, the ladies are led by the experienced Ysabelle Lawrence and Serena Mackenzie and Yeji Lee making her first appearance at the age of 14 and Aleema Jack who is returning to the national team after an absence of 6 years.

The men are led by 3 18 year old teenagers, Sachin Kumar, Liam Bryden (winner of this years' T&T Open), Sam Avey (winner of the RBL Caribbean Junior Open). Talin Rajendranath who at 24 is the most experienced member of the team. Clint Alfred is making his second appearance at 42 and Jonathan Millen also at 42 is making his debut after a series of very consistent golf over the past few years.

The Trinidad & Tobago team will count on the leadership and experience of Coach Chris Harries and manager Elizabeth Lawrence.
