After 3 rounds of the 112th Trinidad & Tobago Open once again played in beautiful conditions at the St Andrews Golf Club in Moka, Maraval. Chris Richards continues to lead the Trinidad & Tobago Open, his three day scores are 68, 70, 73 (211 total) 5 under par. Moving up into second place is defending champions Dustin Risdon who has shot scores of 69, 77, 69 (215 total) 1 under par. Tied in third place are Edgardo Arrazola Jnr and Barbadian Roger Merlin Beale with a total score of 218, with Ben Martin 220. Next on 221 in a tie is Matthew Marquez, Christian De Grief who had a brilliant 67 today and Talin Rajendranath.

The championship division is led by Wanjoo Lee with scores of 72, 74, 71 (217 total), two strokes behind is defending amateur champion Gabriel Vananoste with 73, 76, 70 (219 total). Tied in third place are Liam Bryden 80, 73, 72 (225 total) and Jonathan Millen 76, 71, 78 (225 total). Tobago's Sol Joanni is in 4th place with scores of 78, 76, 76 (230 total).

In the first flight, who played from the Blue tees, Junior Charles has taken a 4 stroke lead with his scores of 79, 78, 76 (233 total) over second placed Rodney Phillip who has scores of 79, 81, 77 (237 total). In third place is Ryan Gomez who has shot 79, 83, 78 (240 total). The winner will most likely come from one of these three as Thomas Bannon and Luke DeFreitas both on 246 may have too much to do on tomorrow the last day.

In the second flight, two national junior team mates will be battling it out tomorrow in the final round. David Bhim 73, 88, 83 (244 total) and Jean-Marc Chevrotierre 78, 82, 84 (244 total) are tied for first place, they are 4 strokes ahead of another pair of Nandlal Ramlakhan 80, 86, 82 (248 total) and Learie Flores 82, 80, 86 (248) who are tied third. Bal Ramdhan is in fifth place 86, 82, 86 (254 total).

In the Seniors' division overnight leader Richard "Pecos" Camacho has seen his lead cut to only 2 strokes with his 3 day total of 72, 75, 82 (229) from Mahendra "Dave" Rajkumar who has rounds of 77, 75, 79 (231 total). Krishna Narine has kept his hold on third place with scores of 76, 83, 78 (237 total)

Fabian Lee Foon the Super Seniors defending champion has extended his lead to an almost unbeatable lead of 19 strokes with his scores of 75, 79, 75 (229 total). Tied in second place are Montgomery Chapman 82, 86, 80 (248 total) and Tyrone Leong 86, 80, 82 (248 total). Selwyn Hakim, Surooj Harripersad and Kissoon Gannes are tied in 4th place with a total of 251.

Spectators are welcome to come out and witness some spectacular, first tee time is 624.
