



SELECTION CRITERIA FOR CAJGC 2017

Trials for this year's the 2017 CAJGC Championships will be held on Saturday May 6th 2017 and on Sunday 17th May 2017.

Performance in the CAJGC Trials is used in assessing the performance of players and **does not in itself guarantee a place on the CAJGC team.**

In addition to the Trials, player performance in the following tournaments and events will be used as a guide to the selectors.

- Performance at CAJGC Championships 2015
- Performance at CAJGC Championship 2016
- Performance at CAGC Championships 2015
- Performance at CAGC Championships 2016
- Performance at RBL Caribbean Junior Open 2016
- Performance at RBL Caribbean Junior Open 2017
- Performance in TTGA Invitational Events within the past 12 months
- Performance in Junior Tournaments held during the last 6 months.
- Performance in International Tournaments
- Participation in the Strive for Excellence Program, including any monthly games organized by the TTGA and or any Club.

Players will be judged on the following in determining the final team.

- Commitment to the game
- Ability to listen to instructions given by person in authority
- Dedication to practice
- Team spirit
- **NOTE:** Etiquette on and off the course

Players offered places on the Junior National Team will be required to sign a contract, along with their parents, that include:

- Practice schedules
- Physical training
- Behavior expectations
- Zero tolerance issues
