Little 10 year old Zico Correia would be again competing in the 11 to 13 boys category. We place our bets on him.

The Trinidad Cup (boys & girls 10 and under competing in a 36 hole tournament) is another highlight to this event, together with the 3, 6 and 9 hole categories.
